French Neoclassicism

- Pierre Peyron (1744-1814) The Death of Alcestis, 1794
- Antonio Canova (1757-1822) Studio of Canova, *Venus Italia*, c.1815-22 Describe how Conova's *Venus* feels.

French Romanticism

- Studio of Jean Baptist Carpeaux, *The Spirit of the Dance*, 1873 (public version 1869) Describe how Carpeaux's *Spirit* feels.
- Emile-Jean-Horace Vernet, Start of the Race. c. 1820

French Impressionism

 Painted over a decade later, how does *Morning Mists* differ from *Maneporte*?
