Ancient Rome to Early Renaissance

Object List

Ancient Italy

- *Aphrodite of Cyrene*, 1st Century, Roman, after Hellenistic original, marble
- *Celestial God or Hero*, Late 2nd to early 3rd century, marble
- *Hercules*, 2nd Century, Roman after Hellenistic original, marble
- *Portrait of Marcus Aurelius*, Late 2nd century, marble
- Roman, *Funerary Monument for Sextus Maelius Stabilio, Vesinia Iucunda, and Sextus Maelius Faustus*, early 1st century, marble
- Roman (Phrygia in Asia Minor), *Funerary Stele of the Priest Dionysios and His Wife, Tertia*, c. 240-260, marble

Italo-Byzantine

- Circle of the Berlinghieri Family. Italian (active about 1200-1274) *Madonna and Child*, c.1230-40

Proto-Renaissance **Compare Berlinghieri and Giotto Marys**

- Giotto di Bondone and assistants, Italian (c.1266/76-1337)
The "Peruzzi Altarpiece," c.1310-15 Tempera and gold leaf on panel
- Puccio Capanna, Italian (active 1325-1350) *Crucifixion*, c. 1330,
Tempera and gold leaf on panel

Early Renaissance

- Alessandro di Mariano Filipepi (called Sandro Botticelli) and assistants, Italian, (1444/45-1510), *The Adoration of the Child*, c. 1500
