
























Inside St Peter's, 1935 Wood engraving, The SI collection






Snow, 1936, Lithograph




Metamorphosis I, May, 1937 Woodcut printed on 2 sheets, National Gallery, Canada




Day and Night, February, 1938 Woodcut in black and grey, printed from 2 blocks, Rock J. Walker



Metamorphosis II, November 1939-March 1940, Woodcut, printed from 20 blocks on 3 combined sheets, Private collection, Texas






















