## Modernism ideas:

- 1. Painting is about painting, not about representation. Emphasis on the formal properties of design and the painted surface itself as the CONTENT of the painting.
- 2. Interest in experimental materials, techniques and processes.
- 3. Abstraction through simplification of the form, as we see in this series of Picassos where the form of the bull is simplified to discover <u>the essence</u> of the bull.
- 4. On the other hand, abstraction could be pure non-objection abstraction, whereas in this Kandinsky, color, line and shape represent the final product.
- 5. Modernism was driven by various social and political agendas. These were often utopian, and modernism was in general associated with ideal visions of human life and society and a belief in progress.
